#### TRAINING PROVIDERS' EXPERIENCES

#### **Client Bodies:**

- Working and setup of Skills Development Departments
- Aging workforce
- The youth's interest to enter a career in construction
- Focus on career path progress and not on skills transfer
- Lack of tools and equipment, material and activities.





#### TRAINING PROVIDERS' EXPERIENCES

#### **Contracting Companies:**

- In general companies do not see the benefit of developing the lower spectrum of their workforce.
- Generally low-level employees are employed from local communities
- To implement training programmes on projects may be disruptive and can cause capacity issues.
- This kind of training tends to be more expensive
