- b) The annual gross turnover of the company, close corporation, partnership or trading trust must be less than ten million Rand (**R10 000 000**) or as amended by the Act from time to time; AND
- c) The total gross asset value of the business - excluding fixed property - must be less than R1 000 000 (one million Rand) or as amended by the Act from time to time; AND
- d) The complement of personnel employed at the business shall not exceed forty nine (49) or as amended by the Act from time to time.
